Imported Draft Beer

- Hacker Pschorr Weisse \$5.50 22oz
Hacker Pschorr Brau; Hefeweizen; 5.5% ABV. Cloudy, Yellow gold with a thick white head. Aroma of citrus and clove.
- Bitburger \$5.00 16oz
Premium Pils; Pilsner; 4.8% ABV. A clear classic pilsner with a light bitter taste. Smooth and very dry. Elegant on draft!
- Paulaner Salvator \$6.00 .5l
Paulaner Brauerei; Doppelbock; 7.9% ABV. Thr Paulaner Original. Served by the monks as a replacement for food during lent.
- Stella Artois \$5.00 50cl
Stella Artois; Euro Pale Lager; 5% ABV. Straw yellow color, mild sour malt aroma.
- Hacker Pschorr Oktoberfest \$6.00 .5l
Hacker Pschorr Brau; Oktoberfest/Marzen; 5.8% ABV. Slow roasted and caramelized to a rich, red amber color, combined with the purest water from the Alps.
- Guinness Stout \$5.50 Imp Pint
Guinness LTD; Irish Dry Stout; 4.20% ABV. Pours deep brown and cascades to black. Creamy white head, burnt coffee and chocolate.
- Lindemans Framboise \$7.50 8oz
Brouwerij Lindemans; Lambic-Fruit; \$.0% ABV. Hazy ruby red color with fluffy pink head. Sweet, tart, and sour raspberries.
- Franziskaner Dunkel Weisse \$5.50 22oz
Spaten-Franziskaner-Brau; Dunkelweizen; 5% ABV. Cloudy amber brown. Presence of cloves, cherries, banana.

Domestic Draft Beer

- Schlitz Gusto \$3.50 16oz
Joseph Schlitz Brewing Co; American Adjunct Lager; 4.7% ABV. The beer that made Milwaukee famous.
- Black Bavarian \$5.00 .5l
Sprecher Brewing Co; Schwarzbier; 5.86% ABV. Dark Sweet Molasses nose, hints of coffee, chocolate, caramel. Medium bodied.
- Riverwest Stein \$4.50 pint
Lakefront Brewing Co; Vienna Lager; 6% ABV. Lightly toasted aromas with hints of caramel. Hop citrus fruitiness. Woody undertones.
- Spotted Cow \$4.50 pint
New Glarus Brewing Co; Farmhouse Ale; 4.8% ABV. Faintly fruity. Pleasantly grainy, light on the tongue, very refreshing.
